During your time in AEN 2, we will expect you to:


- ◆ Always try your best,

I will be learning...

LITERACY We will be working on writing an explanation text about the Alps and writing a persuasive advert to convince people to explore them.



NUMERACY Children will continue to work on using the four operations to solve tricky number problems as well as investigating data and shape.



TOPICS Our topic this term will be looking at the Mountain Ranges in Europe. Specifically the Alps. We will be looking at the weather system in the Alps; who goes there and why and how people stay safe there.



SCIENCE Our topic this half term is Lifecycles. Next half term we will be covering Earth, Moon and Sun and night and day.



COMPUTING In Summer 1 we will be toy makers looking at using Lego to make mechanical toys. In Summer 2 we will become HTML editors, creating and editing webpages.

ART & D.T. We will be creating a solar system using the techniques of colour mixing, marbling and texturing. We will also be using different textures and techniques to create landscapes.

Speech & Language

We will continue to work on our speech and Language skills through a range of games with the Speech and Language Therapist.

Swimming AEN 2 will be continuing with their swimming every Thursday leaving at 12.45. All children must attend these sessions unless they have a valid doctor's note.

Homework Children will be given weekly Literacy and Numeracy homework. Tasks should be completed and returned on a Tuesday.
