I will be learning...

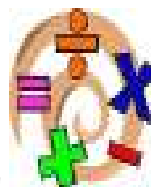
Communication and Language:

Literacy:

Our books for this term are The Gigantic Turnip, Toddle Waddle, We're Going on a Farm Animal Hunt and Rosie's Walk. We are continuing to focus on name writing and using our phonics to write simple words and sentences.

Numeracy:

This term we will be focusing on money, counting, representing number, adding and taking away, measuring, positional language and recording our workings.



Understanding the World:

We will be going on a trip to the farm to look at different farm animals. We will also be looking at growth and planting seeds. We will be using programmable toys and will make them move in certain ways.



Expressive Arts and Design:

As part of our Farm topic we will be creating textured drawings of animals. We will be exploring how colour and sound can be changed. We will also use drawing to record what we have observed in the world around us.

COMPUTING

This term we will be using the beebots to help us with directional language.

We will also be learning that information can be found from computers.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In the summer term we will giving extra responsibility to the children by assigning milk and fruit monitors. We will encourage the children to build on their role play by having a farm shop in the role play area.

Physical Development

We will be focusing on athletics during the summer term. New skills will include jumping, running, kicking and catching. We will continue to develop our physical skills during PE sessions and play.



Our Topic

Our topic for summer is The Farm. We will be visiting Stepney farm for a real-life experience to observe animals closely and talk about what we notice, similarities and differences.
