- ◆ We go swimming on a Wednesday.


I will be learning...

LITERACY AND TOPIC

We will be focusing on World War 2. We will also be writing stories and diaries based on this period of history.



MATHS



During our maths lessons, we will be focusing on learning number facts and practising methods for calculation and problem solving.

HUMANITIES
