LITERACY AND TOPIC

We will be focusing on the Great Fire of London. We will also be writing stories and diaries based on this period of history.



MATHS



During our maths lessons, we will be focusing on learning number facts and practising methods for calculation and problem solving.

It is vital that children continue to practise and learn their times tables at home.

HUMANITIES

Our topic for this term is linked to History. We will be studying the main events of the fire and discovering why it spread so rapidly.

SCIENCE

Our topic this term will be 'Keeping Warm'. We will be looking at thermal and electrical insulators

I.C.T. During ICT we will be learning how to search the internet to research key questions about the Great Fire.

MUSIC Children will continue to learn to play the guitar.

ART & D.T. We will be researching and comparing architecture in London from before and after the Great Fire of London.

P.E. Our P.E. day will be on a Thursday. Children will be studying striking and fielding. If your child is in Year 5 they will have swimming on Thursday afternoons.

R.E. Children will be taking part in our Eid Celebrations in October.

PSHE This term children will be exploring the themes of new beginnings, family relationships and independence.
