LITERACY



In Spring 1 we will focus on the text 'George's Marvellous Medicine' before diving in and becoming pirate experts whilst reading Treasure Island. Our non-fiction work will explore explanation, information and report texts.

MATHS



We will continue to work on using the four operations to solve tricky number problems as well as learning about fractions, measures and shape. Remember: keep practicing your times tables at home!

SCIENCE

Our topics this term are: Changing States and Reversible and Irreversible Changes. This will include learning about evaporation, condensation and the water cycle. We are also using our time to revise all past Science units. These include: rocks and soils, circuits, gases around us and magnetism. We will be focusing on investigative skills and developing our enquiring minds!



COMPUTING We are studying how to be bloggers in Computing. This includes us posting on a blog about our favourite books. We will then be able to comment upon each other's blogs.

ART & D.T. We will be using our observational skills to paint still life pictures. In D&T we will be making healthy pirate snacks.

P.S.H.E We are using our P.S.H.E time this term to focus on conflict resolution and how to deal with feelings and emotions.




SWIMMING We are lucky enough to be able to continue swimming on Thursdays, leaving at 1.00pm and returning by the end of the day. We will be walking to Mile End Leisure Centre where the children will be taught by a trained coach.

FRENCH We have a specialist French teacher who will be teaching everyday conversational French once a week.
