LITERACY

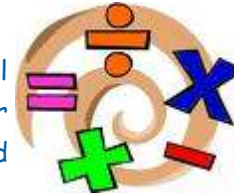
Children will be focusing on persuasion and narrative. This will be linked with our geography topic about St Lucia.



We will become skilled in the art of persuasion, writing and performing adverts. The second term will see us exploring a short animated film by the BFI El Caminate.

NUMERACY

During our maths lessons, we will continue to use the four operations to solve word problems.



One of our main focus areas this term will be to develop our understanding of fractions and decimals. Maths Week in the second half of the Summer term will be about position, direction and movement.

HUMANITIES

This term we will be investigating St Lucia. We will be working on our core skills such as map reading and using compass points.



We will be exploring the human and natural features of the country.

SCIENCE

In the first half of the summer term, we will be learning about moving and growing. We will be carrying out observational drawings of bones and the human skeleton and also carrying out investigations into the diets of invertebrates. In the second half, we will be looking at habitats, food chains and adaptation.

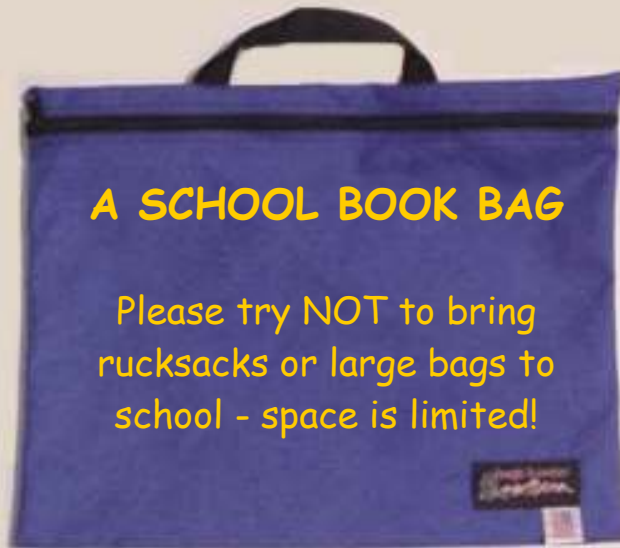


SCHOOL SHOES
