I will be learning...

LITERACY

Children will be focusing on narrative and non-fiction this term. We will be immersing ourselves in the wonderful world of fantasy and learning how to write free verse poetry. In our non-fiction work we will be writing reports on mythical beasts and explaining processes precisely.



Please make sure that your child is reading lots of myths, legends and non fiction at home.

MATHS

In Maths, we will be deepening our understanding of fractions and decimals, exploring measurement of area and time.



Keep practicing those times tables.

SCIENCE

This term we will be investigating changing states of matter. This will include finding out about solids, liquids and gases and how they transform from one state to another.

We will also have a short additional lesson every week where the children will have the opportunity to revise some key scientific concepts that they have previously learnt. These will include: teeth, plants, rocks and soils and properties of materials.



Computing Our unit this term is "We Are Toy Makers". We will be building and programming Lego toys and learning how to debug programs too .

Music We will be listening to and improvising traditional music this term.

RE This term we will be learning about the similarities and differences between religious leaders in Christianity and Judaism.

PSHE We will be focussing on ourselves, our family and our friends and our relationships. We will also be exploring how our feelings are affected by or can affect our relationships.

Art & D.T. In Art based on the theme of dreams and fantasy, we will be exploring how images can be used to create a mood or atmosphere and creating our own photo collages. In DT, we will be designing and creating storybooks with moving parts.

P.E. PE will continue to be on a Thursday this term. We will be learning gymnastics skills and how to play tag rugby.

Things you will need in Year 4...

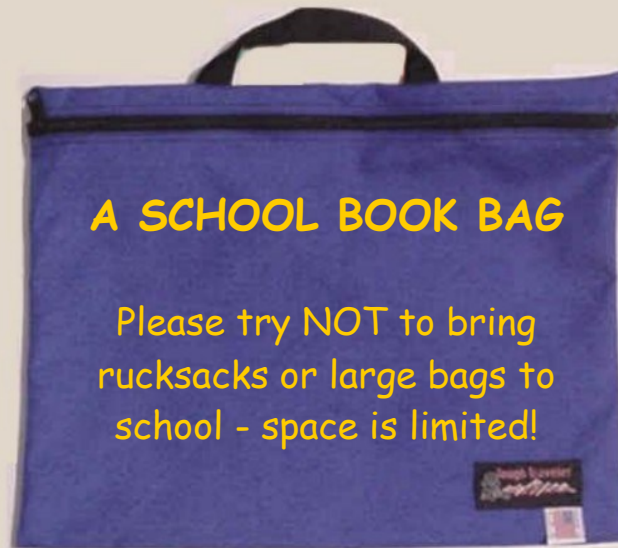


SCHOOL SHOES
