- bring your swimming kit every Thursday.

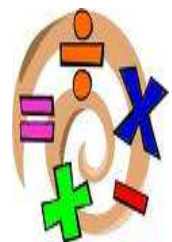
I will be learning...

LITERACY



In Spring 1 we will be reading *The Highwayman* and focusing on storytelling and narrative poetry. In Spring 2 we are reading *How to Train Your Dragon* and will be writing our own fiction stories.

MATHS



We will continue to work on using the four operations to solve tricky number problems as well as learning about fractions, measures and shape. Remember: keep practicing your targets and times tables at home!

SCIENCE

Our topics this term are: *Changing States and Reversible and Irreversible Changes*. This will include learning about evaporation, condensation and the water cycle. We will be focusing on investigative skills and developing our enquiring minds!

In Spring 1 we will also be celebrating 'Science Week.' This will be linked to our poetry and PE.



COMPUTING We will be using a computer program called *Sketch-Up* to become architects and designing a hideout for the Highwayman.

ART & D.T. We will be designing our own 3D containers and vessels in Spring 1. In Spring 2 we will be making bread and linking this with our Science topic, reversible and irreversible changes.

P.S.H.E

This term we are going to be working with the *Loyds Community Programme* to learn about managing money and engaging in the world of work.



SWIMMING Year 5 are lucky enough to continue going swimming every Thursday, leaving at 1.00pm and returning by the end of the day. We will be walking to Mile End Leisure Centre where the children will be taught by a trained coach.

FRENCH We will be continuing to learn about ourselves, our families, and our hobbies.

TRIPS & EVENTS We will visit a Sikh temple of worship (*Gurdwara*) to develop our understanding of the Sikh religion. We will also be going to visit the Bank of England Museum to support our PSHE topic.
