I will be learning...

LITERACY Children will be writing a range of persuasive texts and reports linked to cross curricular topics in Science and History.



NUMERACY Children will be diving into algebra, calculating with decimals and wrangling with fractions.



HUMANITIES This term children will be researching life during World War Two in Britain. We are learning about the Blitz and the impact it had on London.



SCIENCE Early on in the term children will be investigating how animals and plants are adapted to live in particular environments. We will also be looking at why food goes mouldy and useful microbes.



Year 6 residential! We will be going away to KINGSWOOD for an amazing few days to experience a range of activities to develop children's social skills and independence.

I.C.T We will be learning how to handle data and learning how to carry out digital research.

Music Children will be learning about the style of Music that was enjoyed during the World War II era and composing their own.
