During your time in Year 6, we will expect you to:

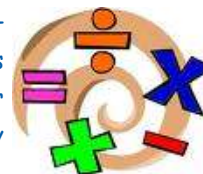
- ◆ Always put in 100% effort.
- ◆ Aim to have 100% attendance (research shows that there is a direct link between Level 4 and 5 SATs results and extremely high attendance).
- ◆ Be kind and considerate to everyone.
- ◆ Do your homework to a high standard - homework to be given in every Tuesday, when new homework will be given out.
- ◆ Read regularly (15 minutes per day) and fill in reading journals
- ◆ Complete Manga High and Bug Club activities.
- ◆ Attend clubs weekly if invited.
- ◆ Practise your spellings.
- ◆ Look after your own things.
- ◆ Make sure you wear the correct uniform with the appropriate footwear.
- ◆ Bring your PE kit in on Fridays.

I will be learning...

LITERACY During the first half of the summer term, we will be writing spy stories and persuasive texts. We will be revising grammatical rules and applying these in our writing.



NUMERACY We will be revising all elements of the mathematics curriculum. We will be preparing for secondary school by exploring algebra in more detail.



HUMANITIES During the first half of the summer term, we will be focusing on how Britain has changed since the 1940's. We will be exploring the culture of the 40's, 50's and 60's

In the second part, we will be researching Australia. As part of Maths and ICT week we will be using ICT to explore the traditions of this country.

ART & DT We will be researching, designing and creating our piece of Aboriginal art.

SCIENCE We will be revising the core elements of science in preparation for SATS and secondary school



I.C.T. We will be linking our ICT work to our humanities topic. Please ensure your child is using their laptop at home appropriately and completing homework tasks .

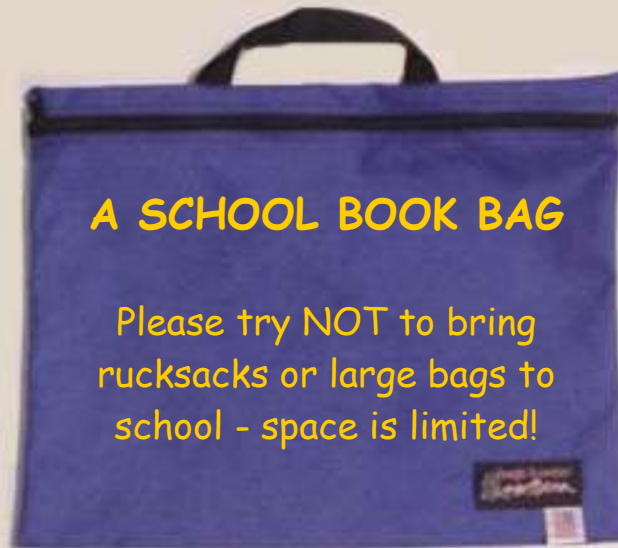


SCHOOL SHOES
